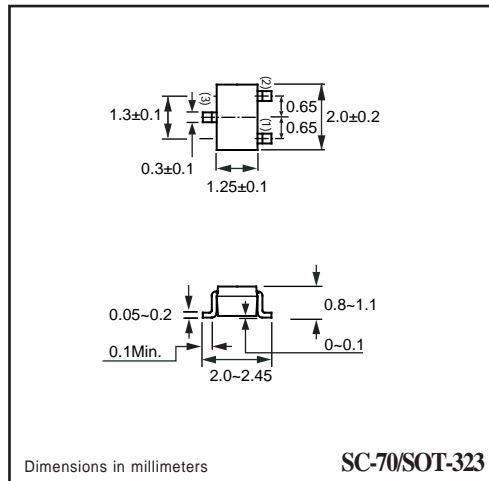
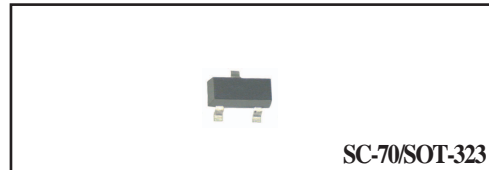

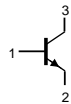

fig1. Grounded emitter output characteristics

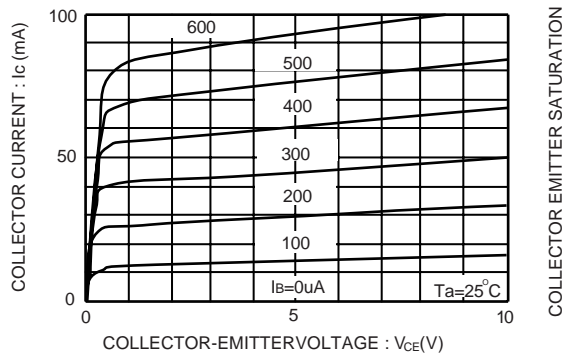
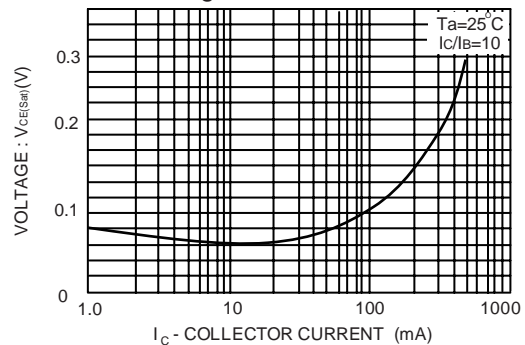


fig2. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs Collector Current

fig3.DC current gain VS. collector current ( 1 )

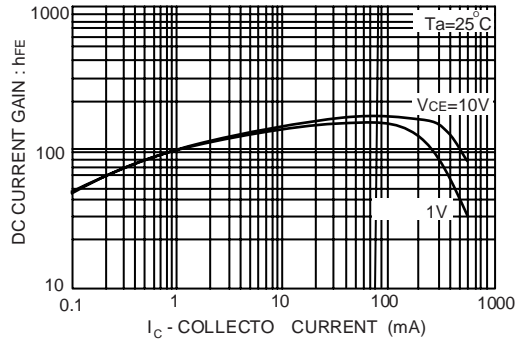


fig4.DC current gain VS. collector current ( 2 )

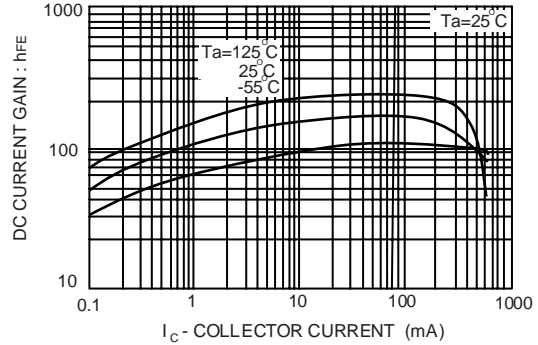


fig5.AC current gain VS. collector current

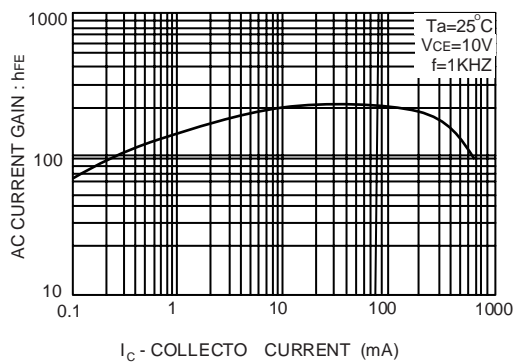


fig6.Base-emitter saturation voltage VS. collector current

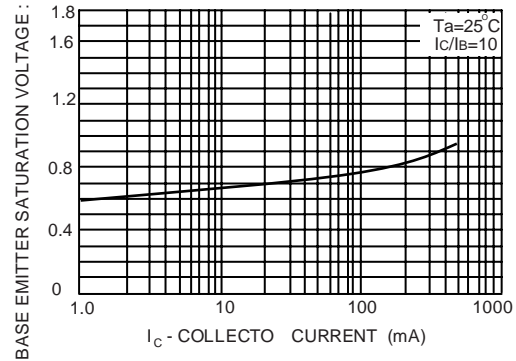


fig7.Grounded emitter propagation characteristics

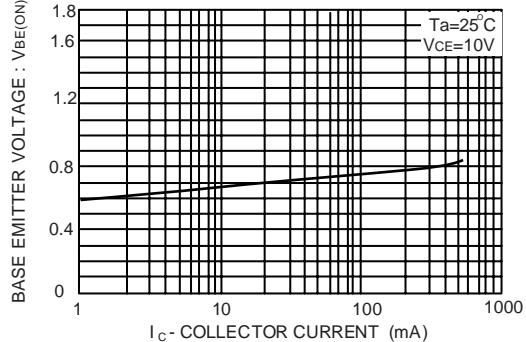
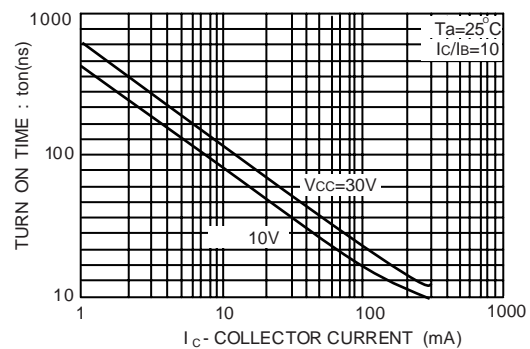


fig8.Turn-on time VS. collector current

fig9. Rise time VS. collector current

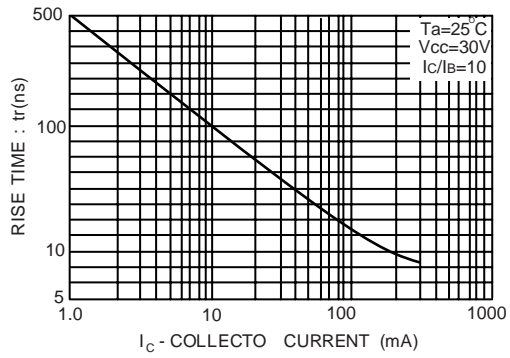


fig10. Fall time VS. collector current

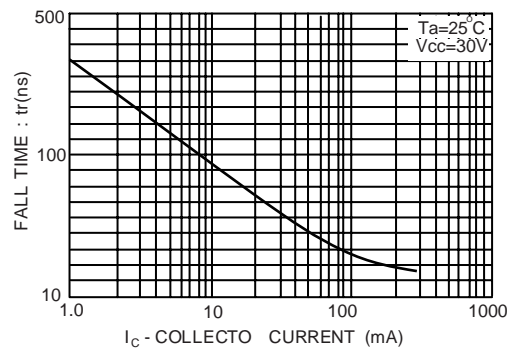


fig11. Input / output capacitance VS. voltage
